

President Mbeki speaks at the Bhambatha Centenary Commemoration

President Thabo Mbeki will on Sunday 11 June at 10:00 attend the commemoration and the reinstatement of Inkosi Bhambatha at Greytown in Mpanza (Ngome), KwaZulu-Natal Province. The President will be accompanied by several Cabinet Ministers, KwaZulu-Natal Premier Sbusiso Ndebele, senior government officials and advisors.

As part of the commemoration, President Mbeki will lay a wreath at the Bhambatha memorial site and proceed to Mpanza where he will deliver a keynote address. The reinstatement is part of a wider programme of celebrations for the 100 years of the Bhambatha Centenary.
